**Yarn**—will be crocheted into children's hats.

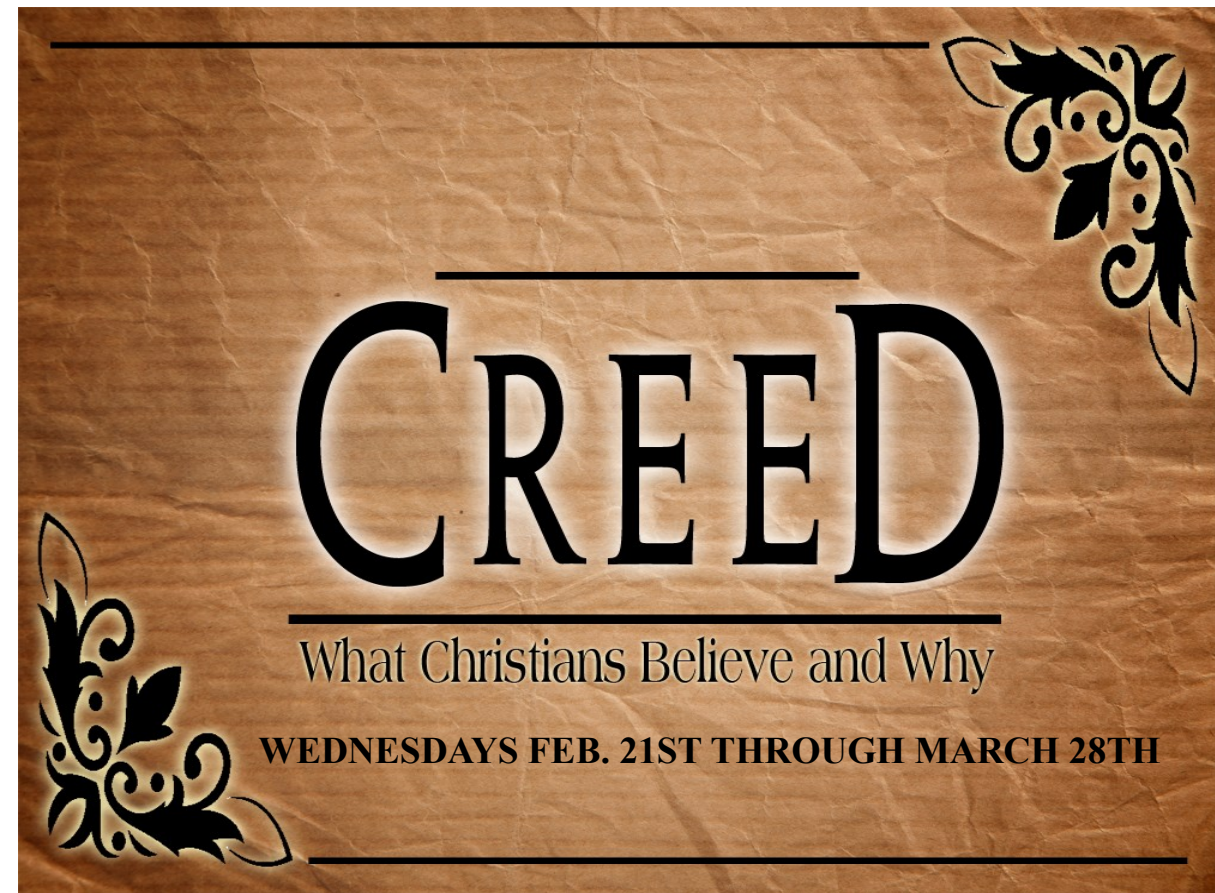
**Sewing Notions**—zippers, ribbon, large buttons, will be sewn into dresses and tote bags.
