Length of commitment: Two years

  - Check with the front office to verify those in need...shut-ins, elderly and hospitalized.
  - The size and number of arrangements depends on how many people are on the list.
- The location for making the arrangements is in the church kitchen by the dish washer.
  - There is a large cabinet that stores the supplies needed for this ministry.
