 - Plan - How your team can organize the kitchen to be the most useful, productive and user friendly layout to help our many ministries be as successful as possible.
 - Use this team to.
 - Set rules and guidelines for the kitchen use.
 - Set rules, guidelines and operating procedures for the equipment use.
 - I.E. Stove, Ovens, Refrigerators and Freezers, Coffee and Tea Makers, Dish Washer, etc.

- Meet with each ministry that uses the kitchen to help them understand any rules, guidelines, operating procedures, layout and function ability.
