Job Duties

- Be in prayer for our church family and those new members who come to be a part of our church family.
- New Member/Family Mentor Program and Procedures
 - Upon receiving the names of a new member/family you will need to contact them as soon as possible to set up a time to meet.
 - Be creative about your meeting place. You can meet in their home, meet for lunch or coffee, etc.
 - If meeting in person is not possible, then continue with the following procedure by phone.
 - Try not to make contact by email or text. We want to connect by face or voice if at all possible.
 - Be as prepared as possible to offer information, or point them to the right person to find the information they are looking for.
 - Children's, Student, College, Senior Adult, Missions, Family Ministry, Worship, etc.
 - A great resource for basic information is the church website www.fwbfumc.org
 - Other great resources are the many department brochures located in the kiosks around the facility.

- Offer to meet them on a Sunday morning to introduce them to other church members and to help show them around the facility and find the right places for their family.
- Encourage them to return the Family Information Sheet and Every Member in Ministry forms from the New Member Packets as soon as possible.
 - The information on these forms will allow us to better connect with them. And allows them to be connected quicker with their areas of interest.
- Most of all, spend time sharing life and building relationships with our new members/families.
- Offer a way for them to contact you if they have any future thoughts, questions or concerns.
